- Develop and maintain a schedule for adoration.
- Ensure that person(s) are present during the hours of adoration.
- Arrange the set-up of flowers and candles for adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
- Address other matters, as they arise, regarding the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
