Position Overview

The Totus Tuus Camp Volunteer assists the parish priests, Coordinator(s) and Missionaries to provide a faith-filled, safe, and fun camp experience for children from grades 1-12.

Activities/Responsibilities

- Assist the priests, Totus Tuus Coordinator(s) and Missionaries as required
- Responsible for supervising and interacting with campers, assuring their safety, health, and well-being to the best of his or her ability
- Participate in Mass activities by singing, responding, etc., to help children worship, learn, and have fun
- Fulfill assigned duties and seeking clarification and/or assistance as needed.
- Know the location of emergency exits, first aid kits, fire extinguishers. In case of an emergency, will follow established protocols
- Model respectful and appropriate behaviour at all times, particularly in regards to worship, language, and modest attire
- Refrain from the use of cell phones (calls, texts, social media, "surfing", etc.) during the day when in the presence of campers, unless given specific permission by the Coordinator(s)
- Assist in the physical set-up and take-down of chairs, tables, etc.
- Cleans up and returns materials to their proper storage area after each session
- Attend the Totus Tuus commissioning Mass, orientation, training, camp, and potluck

Screening Requirements

Before volunteering begins:

- Complete a Volunteer Application Form
- Attend interview and have personal references checked
- Complete a Police Information Check
- Complete appropriate training and orientation

After volunteering begins:

- There will be supervision and periodic evaluations
- An annual Offence Declaration and a new Police Information Check every 5 years
- Participant follow-ups may be conducted
