

Ministry Position: Totus Tuus Parish Host Family

Position Overview

Totus Tuus (Latin for *Totally Yours*) is a parish-based summer catechetical program for youth in grades 1-12, with day camp for those in grades 1-6 and an evening camp for those in grades 7-12. Totus Tuus gathers highly trained college-age missionaries in teaching teams of four and sends them out on the road to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ in various participating parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Toronto. These missionaries spend the summer living and working together.

The role of the Totus Tuus Host Family is to provide accommodations for two to four missionaries for five nights (they arrive the Sunday before the start of the camp and depart the following Friday). Note: Missionaries will be at the Parish most of the time (approximately from 8:00am-9:30pm), with the possibility of a return to the host family in-between day and evening camps.

Activities/Responsibilities

- Provide comfortable living and sleeping arrangements
- Provide a simple breakfast each morning
- Provide dinner in the event that participating Parishes do not run evening programs
- Provide parking for one vehicle

Screening Requirements

Before volunteering begins:

- Complete a Volunteer Application Form
- · Attend interview and have personal references checked
- Complete a Police Information Check (primary contact/s)
- Complete appropriate orientation

After volunteering begins:

- There will be supervision
- An annual Offence Declaration and a new Police Information Check every 5 years (if a reoccurring volunteer)
- Participant follow-ups may be conducted

Length of Ministry Appointment
