We are pleased to announce the 2023 virtual training schedule for the Volunteer Screening Program "*Strengthening Our Caring Community*". This 2-part training program is an opportunity for new Pastors and Volunteer Screening Coordinators to review the policies and procedures for implementing and maintaining the Volunteer Screening program within their parish. Existing Volunteer Screening Coordinators should also attend this training every 2-3 years as a refresher.

During the week of February 20th, all Parishes and Volunteer Screening Coordinators will receive an email (in their parish and parish screening mailboxes) inviting them to register for the training and asking them to extend the invitation to screening committee members, ministry leaders, and anyone else in the parish who is involved in the intake, management, and screening of volunteers. Please note that Part I and Part II are required to be completed.
