Overview:

Holy Family Parish is seeking a modified full time Youth Minister to implement an all-encompassing strategy for a sustainable youth ministry.

This position requires at least 25-30 hours of work per week as needed by the Pastor (or Administrator), including some evenings and Saturdays.

Responsibilities:

Rooted Ministry Development

- Oversee and direct ministry (grades 3-5 students) that provides a strong catechetical, social and relevant issue component to its sessions (Saturday Evenings)
- Recruit, develop, and oversee a team of volunteers to assist in ministry
- Establish and maintain a presence in parish schools and develop healthy relationships with staff and students
- Plan, promote, prepare resources, and execute bi-weekly sessions/gatherings (Saturdays 3:00 pm 4:30 pm)
- Coordinate one or two retreats per year

EDGE Youth Ministry Development

- Oversee and direct ministry (grades 6-8 students) that provides a strong catechetical, social and relevant issue component to its sessions
- Recruit, develop, and oversee a team of volunteers to assist in ministry
- Establish and maintain a presence in parish schools and develop healthy relationships with staff and students
- Plan, promote, prepare resources, and execute bi-weekly session/gatherings (Saturday Evenings after the evening vigil mass)
- Coordinate one or two retreats per year

Life-teen Youth Ministry

- Oversee and direct ministry (grade 9-12 students) that provides a strong catechetical, social and relevant issue component to its sessions
- Recruit, develop, and oversee a team of volunteers to assist in ministry
- Establish and maintain a presence in parish schools and develop healthy relationships with staff and students
- Plan, promote, prepare resources, and execute bi-weekly session/gatherings (Saturday Evenings after the evening vigil mass)

Coordinate one or two retreats per year

Confirmation Preparation

- Work with existing team of volunteers to create a solid and engaging Confirmation preparation process
- Examine and note areas that can improve for following year's offerings
- Research other preparation processes/material to help improve offerings
- Run and oversee an in-depth and transformative Confirmation retreat
- Follow up with Confirmandii post Confirmation, invite more into the parish

Summer Camp Programs

- Help in the preparations for all the aspects of Holydays Summer day Camp
- Oversee Totus Tuus preparation and logistics
- Network and review other parish camp offerings for points of comparison
- Develop plans for parish to run its own summer camp options/experiences for following summer

Administration, Coordination, & Future Growth

- Foster an environment that supports youth ministry across the parish and its various ministries
- Visit schools connected to the parish at least once to twice a week
- Network with existing youth ministers in the Archdiocese to enhance opportunities, experiences, and resources
- Recruit, form, and direct all youth ministry volunteers
- Oversee and balance the youth ministry budget
- Develop social media platforms and networking options to communicate and enhance ministry outreach (and help in the parish office to update the communications in the parish website)
- Attend conferences and events to support the ongoing development and growth of youth ministry
- Other duties, as required

General Requirements:

- Possess related education/formation/training background
- Be in full communion with the Catholic Church (fully sacramentally initiated), respectful of the Pope, bishops, and pastor
- Have a mature spiritual life
- Be a strong and proficient communicator with suitable administrative skills and strong interpersonal skills
- Have knowledge about updating the Parish website
- Able to work collaboratively as a member of the parish pastoral team
- Excited about transmitting the Catholic Christian faith to the youth
- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada
- A criminal background check will be required of the successful applicant

Benefits:

This role is eligible for:

- 3 weeks of vacation at 25-30 hours per week
- Group benefits plan after 3 months (Health, Dental, Life Insurance, Travel Medical Insurance, Long Term Disability, and Employee and Family Assistance Program)

- Defined Benefit pension plan with a 1%, 2% or 5% contribution match after eligibility requirements outlined in our Policies and Procedural Manual are met
- Access to family-friendly policies including Maternity/Parental Leave top-up benefits and paid sick days which can be used for family caregiving due to emergency or sickness
- Reimbursement for professional designation/membership fees and continuing education
- Paid annual retreat days and moving days
