Overview:

Nativity of Our Lord Parish is seeking a modified full time Youth Ministry to oversee the existing youth ministry programs and develop/facilitate events and programs that support the youth ministry vision within our vibrant Parish Community.

Responsibilities:

Edge Ministry

- Oversee and direct the grade 6 8 at the parish that provides a strong catechetical, social and relevant issue component to its bi-weekly sessions
- Recruit, develop, and lead a team of volunteers to assist in this "tween" program

Lifeteen High School Ministry

- Oversee the parish Life Teen program that provides a strong catechetical, social and relevant issue component to its sessions bi-weekly
- Recruit, form, and train (or arrange for) a team of parish volunteers to assist in this teen program
- Prepare and run a yearly high school ministry retreat
- Prepare and run a retreat for volunteer leaders in the youth ministry programs (annual)

Sacrament of Confirmation Preparation

- Direct the Sacrament of Confirmation process through the parish that is comprehensive, and handle the responsibilities of the Celebration of the Confirmation itself (liturgical & administrative)
- Run the necessary Confirmation Retreat for confirmandi
- Recruit, direct, and form leaders to assist with Sacrament of Confirmation

Camp Ministry Opportunities

- Prepare and provide parish summer day camp for children in grade 1-5
- Assist in providing opportunities for parish "EDGE" kids to attend summer EDGE Camp
- Complete yearly Canada Summer Jobs grant application
- Provide leadership training, direction, and support for parish staff and volunteers of camps

Other Duties

• Engage in relational ministry by scheduling school visits and develop healthy relationships with the students and relevant staff, and reach out to them in other possible ways

- Develop and advocate for creating an environment that supports youth ministry across the parish and its ministries
- Develop necessary Social Media outlets and networking options to communicate and enhance ministry outreach
- Network with existing Catholic Youth Ministries in the Archdiocese to enhance opportunities, experiences and resources that could benefit the parish
- Establish healthy interactions and opportunities for parents to connect to the ministries
- Research and pursue appropriate youth conferences and events to support parish ministry
- Oversee the parish youth ministry budget development and usage
- Work collaboratively as a member of the parish pastoral team
- Other duties, as required

General Requirements:

- College or university degree or equivalent formation/training suited to the work required for this position
- Previous leadership experience in youth ministry (EDGE, LIFETEEN, OCY Summer Camp, Totus Tuus) will be definite assets
- In full communion with the Catholic Church and actively practising the Catholic faith
- A good understanding and acceptance of Catholic Church teaching
- A mature spiritual life
- Respect for Church leadership as well as parish clergy
- Able to work independently and collaboratively as a member of the parish pastoral team
- Able to work during the day, evenings and weekends as necessary
- Possess an above average knowledge in the use of technology such as social media
- Be a strong and proficient communicator with suitable administrative skills and strong interpersonal skills
- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada
- A criminal background check will be required of the successful applicant
