Overview:

Blessed Sacrament Parish is seeking a part time Cook to prepare meals, as well as plan meals and purchase food items for the priest living in the rectory.

Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the pastor in determining meal schedule, special meals and budget
- Plan meals, shop and purchase food items
- Cook meals, clean the premises and items, empty dishwasher
- Purchase and/or order household cleaning supplies
- Maintain clean hygienic conditions; to include sanitizing, dusting, sweeping, vacuuming, mopping kitchen floors
- Use safe food handling practises
- Report malfunctioning equipment or any unsafe conditions in the kitchen or cafeteria and suggest possible solutions to hazards to the Pastor
- Other duties, as required

General Requirements:

- High school diploma
- 3-5 years of relevant service in a similar position
- Professional, pleasant, reliable, positive attitude and courteous with a welcoming disposition
- Strong communication skills, both written and verbal
- Valid driver's license and access to personal vehicle for shopping
- Able to withstand long hours of standing, bending and moving around
- Able to lift weights of at least 35 pounds
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions
- Can work independently with minimum supervision or with a team
- Knowledge of health and safety standards
- Formal training in the food services field is highly desirable
- Ability to maintain discretion and confidentiality
