#### Overview

Adhering to established standards, procedures, and policies, the **Power Plant Engineer** ensures the physical infrastructure of the Seminary's properties are functioning effectively & efficiently. Reporting to the Chief Engineer, this role is responsible for the electrical, mechanical and telecommunication systems of both the Main Campus (early-to-mid 20<sup>th</sup> century construction) in Scarborough and its secondary location in Downtown Toronto (completed in 2023).

# Responsibilities

- Inspect, monitor, test, and analyze systems & equipment to optimize performance while taking into consideration cost, local and/or facility-wide process impact, equipment capabilities and potential effects on environment
- Perform process control, operational laboratory, and boiler water tests as required
- Record all required readings to maintain accurate records regarding plant operations
- Diagnose and repair deficiencies with equipment, ensuring minimal downtime
- Confer with Chief Engineer on job order requests, procurement of parts & tools, and make repairs to equipment
- Isolate and lock out equipment to support/perform maintenance activities
- Perform general building repairs including preventative maintenance activities
- Liaise with TSSA and other government agencies
- Ensure compliance with all applicable regulations and standard operating procedures
- Ensure a safe and clean work environment in accordance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act
- Represent St. Augustine's in a positive manner, ensuring all interactions with external parties reflect well on the Seminary and Archdiocese of Toronto
- Respond to emergency on-call situations
- All other duties as assigned by the Chief Engineer

# **Experience and General Requirements**

- Must possess and maintain a current Certificate of Qualification as an Operating Engineer Third Class or better, in accordance with Ontario Reg. 219/01 as amended
- Ability to work outside normal working hours including weekends, nights, and to report to call-outs & emergency situations
- Valid full driver's license and access to a vehicle for travel to and from sites
- Prior knowledge of Johnson Controls Metasys BAS, HTS BAS, Unilux boilers, and/or Weishaupt burners an asset
- Comfort and adaptability to working with and for priests and seminarians
- Fluent English with professional verbal and written communication skills
- A criminal background check will be required of the successful applicant
- This is an on-site position where the employee is expected to commute daily
