We are pleased to announce the 2024 virtual training schedule for the Volunteer Screening Program “*Strengthening Our Caring Community*”. This virtual training session is an opportunity for new Pastors and Volunteer Screening Coordinators to review the policies and procedures for implementing and maintaining the Volunteer Screening program within their parishes. Existing Volunteer Screening Coordinators should also attend this training every 2-3 years as a refresher.

Two weeks prior to the scheduled training date, all Pastors and Volunteer Screening Coordinators will receive an email (in their parish screening mailbox) inviting them to register for the training and asking them to extend the invitation to screening committee members, ministry leaders, and anyone else in the parish who is involved in the intake, management, and screening of volunteers.
