

A Church that Listens: Ecumenical Panel on Synodality

Tuesday, February 15, 2022 at 12pm Eastern

A special session for bishops, ecumenical officers, and diocesan synod coordinators

A panel discussion on what Catholics can learn from our ecumenical partners on synodality in the life and mission of the church. As Cardinals Mario Grech and Kurt Koch write: "as ecumenism can be understood as an 'exchange of gifts', one of the gifts Catholics can receive from other Christians is precisely their experience and understanding of synodality."

This online panel will reflect on the current synodal process leading to the 2023 Synod of Bishops on synodality. Pope Francis has invited the whole church, Catholic and ecumenical, to reflect on the ways that we are "walking together" in communion and on how the Holy Spirit is calling us to act.
