Day 1 – Mon. Nov. 10 Depart Toronto

We meet at Toronto Airport for our evening departure to Rome. Enjoy complimentary meals and beverage service during the overnight flight.

Day 2 – Tue. Nov. 11 Arrive Rome

Upon arrival in **Rome**, we have a "meet and greet" and together, we begin our journey with a "get acquainted" tour of the "Eternal City". We will see such sights as the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, the Trevi Fountain, the Spanish Steps, and the Pantheon. After our first day filled with the beauty of Rome, we'll check into our hotel, conveniently located within easy walking distance to the Vatican. After Mass today we'll enjoy a tasty dinner. (D) Overnight – Rome – Grand Hotel Olympic – 6 nights

Day 3 – Wed. Nov. 12 Rome / Papal Audience
Early this morning, we walk to St. Peter's Square to
attend the Wednesday Papal Audience (schedule
permitting). After a lunch break, together we will pass
through the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica. We will
have some free time to explore the Basilica before
making our way back to the hotel for dinner. Mass will be
scheduled based on our Holy Door reservation. (B, D)



Day 4 – Thu. Nov. 13 Rome / Exploring Catholic Rome After breakfast at the hotel, we have an early morning

walking guided visit of the *Vatican Museums* to see some of the priceless and irreplaceable art, treasures and relics, the beauty of which reflects a positive joy and hope. We will go on to visit the magnificent *Sistine Chapel*, one of the most visited chapels in the world, where cardinals vote in conclave before *Michelangelo's Last Judgement*. We will then make our way to the *Basilica of St. Mary Major*, one of four major papal basilicas and the largest Marian church in Rome. Here we will see relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem and the high altar which contains relics of *St. Matthew the Evangelist*. There is an icon believed to be "written" by St. Luke. The impressive mosaics are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. Depending on availability, we will pass through the *Holy Door*. After Holy Mass, we will return to our hotel and the remainder of the afternoon is free. (B, D)



Day 5 - Fri. Nov. 14 Day Excursion to Assisi

Today, we travel by private coach to Assisi, with Holy Mass at the Basilica of St. Francis



(pending confirmation), followed by a guided tour visiting the major sites associated with St. Francis and St. Clare. On a walking tour, visit the **Basilica of St.**Mary of the Angels, the site where 800 years ago, St. Francis renounced his family inheritance. Then go to Chiesa Nuova, a seventeenth-century, Renaissance-style church built on the grounds where St. Francis was born. Visit San Damiano, the church where St. Francis heard God's call and where St. Clare founded her religious community, the Poor Clares. Also, the Basilica of St. Clare a 13th-century church that houses the *incorrupt relics of St. Clare* as well as the *miraculous "San Damiano" crucifix* that spoke

to Francis. Return to Rome for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

Day 6 – Sat. Nov. 15 Rome

Today, we will continue our visits to the remaining Papal Basilicas. Each of these Basilicas has the distinction of having a "holy door" opened only during the Jubilee year. We visit the *Cathedral of St. John Lateran*, founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and, the first Christian church to be consecrated. Our intention is to pass through the *Holy Door* here (pending confirmation). It was home to popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. The "holy heads" of *St. Peter and St. Paul*" are within *two ornate reliquaries high above the main altar*. Then, we'll visit the *Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls*, built by Constantine in the 4th century. Visit the *Holy Door. St. Paul* is buried here and above the tomb are the *chains that were used to imprison him prior to his martyrdom.* The main



altar in the left transept is dedicated to the conversion of St. Paul. Then, we travel down the *Appian Way*, one of the earliest roads built in ancient Rome, to explore the *Domitilla Catacombs* where the early Christians hid themselves to escape persecution. This evening, we will have the opportunity to attend Mass as Cardinal Leo takes "possession" of his Roman Church, the parish of **Santa Maria della Salute in Primavalle**. (B, D)

Day 7 – Sun. Nov. 16 Jubilee for The Poor / Free Time in Rome
We'll leave the hotel early this morning and walk to *St. Peter's Square* for a special Mass to honour the *Jubilee for the Poor*. This afternoon you may relax or explore independently. Our guides may suggest some sights or walks for you to enjoy. Tonight, we enjoy our Farewell Dinner. (B, D)

Day 8 – Mon. Nov. 17 Return to Toronto

After breakfast, transfer to Rome Airport for our return flight to Toronto. (B)
